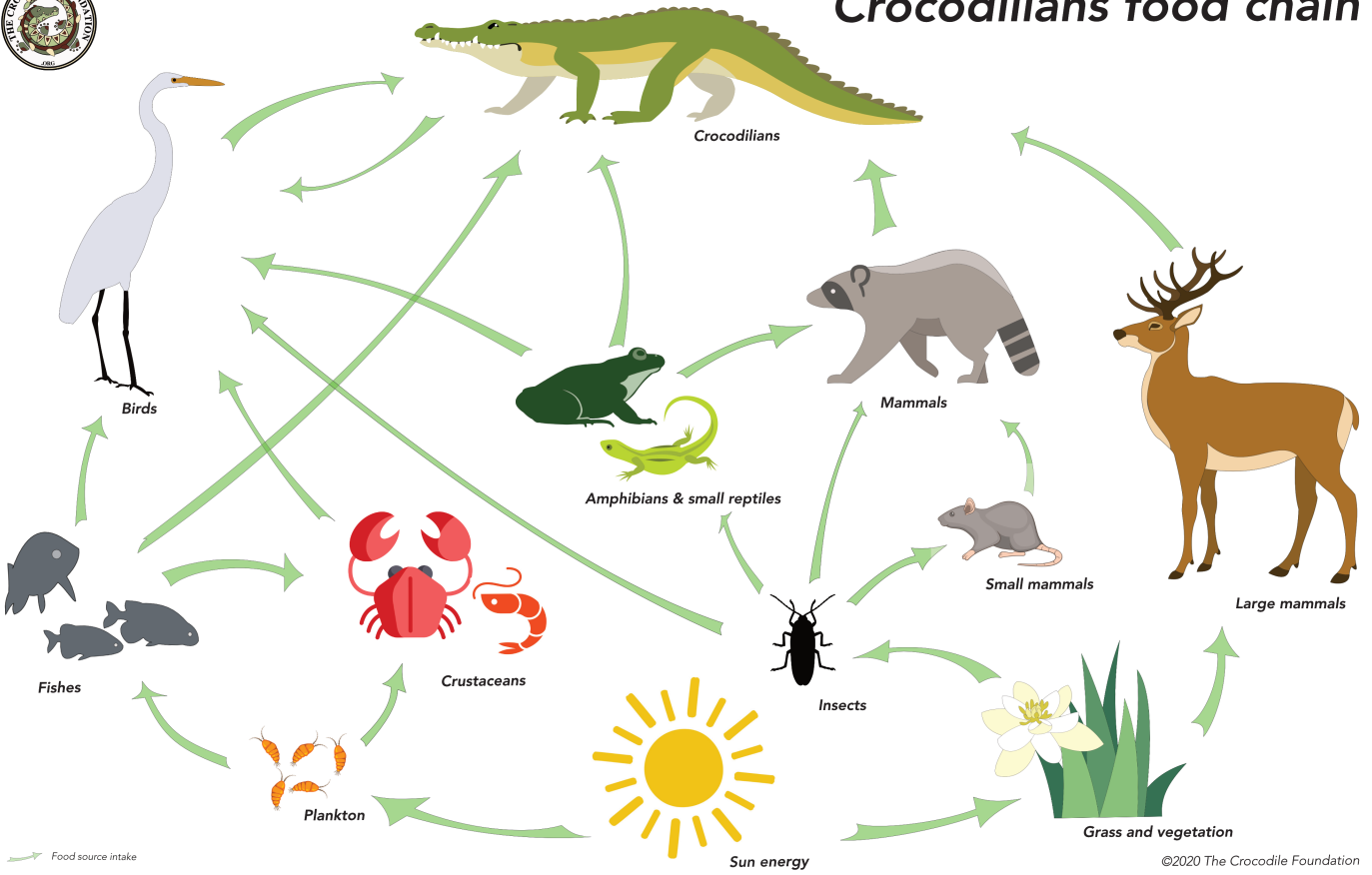




Crocodylians food chain

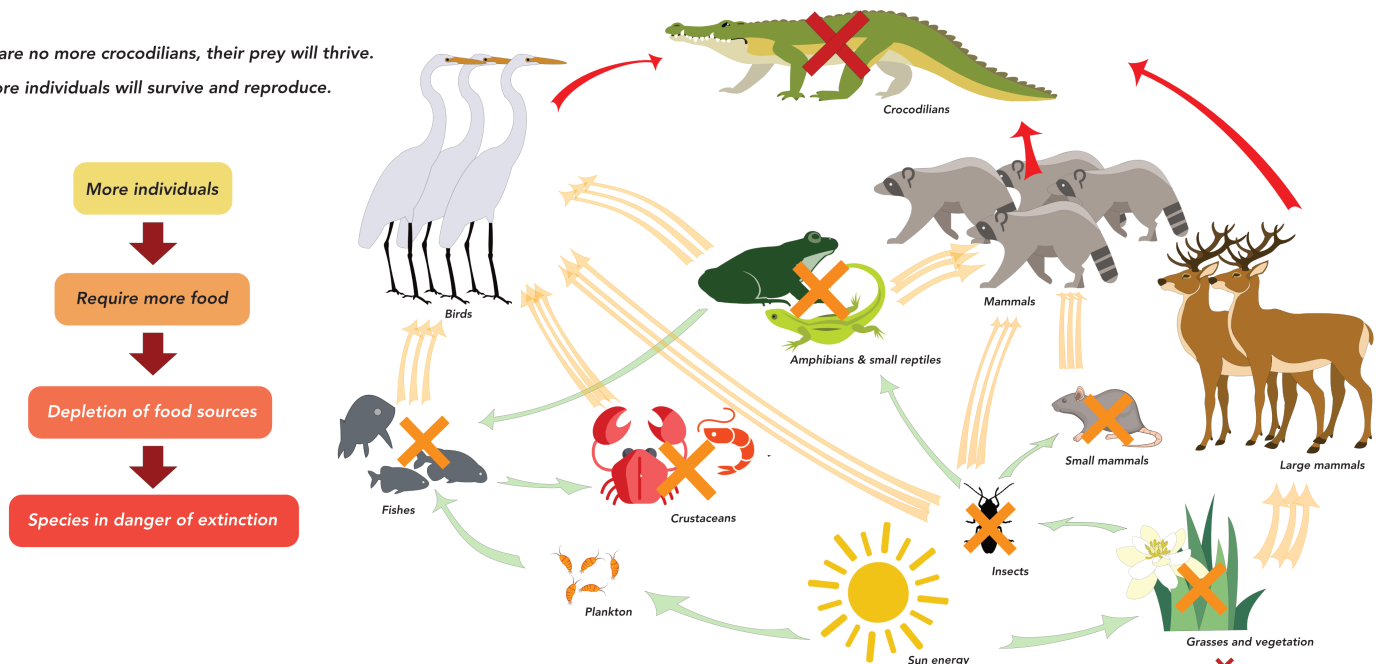


Why Crocodilians are important?
